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SLOVENIJA - FACTS

- ❑ ONE OF THE YOUNGER AND SMALLER CENTRAL EUROPEAN COUNTRIES.
- ❑ A COUNTRY THAT MEASURES SLIGHTLY ABOVE 20,000 KM², WITH A POPULATION OF SLIGHTLY BELOW 2 MILLION.
- ❑ ECONOMICALLY, A MEDIUM DEVELOPED COUNTRY WITH A GNP OF EUR 13,670 PER CAPITA WITH A MARKEDLY EXPERT ORIENTED ECONOMY.
- ❑ APP. 9% OF THE WHOLE POPULATION ARE PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.
- ❑ APP. 16,5% OF THE WHOLE POPULATION ARE OVER 65 YEARS OLD.



THE CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE 14* (EQUALITY BEFORE THE LAW)

IN SLOVENIA EVERYONE SHALL BE GUARANTEED
EQUAL HUMAN RIGHTS AND FUNDAMENTAL
FREEDOMS IRRESPECTIVE OF NATIONAL ORIGIN,
RACE, SEX, LANGUAGE, RELIGION, POLITICAL OR
OTHER CONVICTION, MATERIAL STANDING, BIRTH,
EDUCATION, SOCIAL STATUS, **DISABILITY** OR ANY
OTHER PERSONAL CIRCUMSTANCE.
ALL ARE EQUAL BEFORE THE LAW.
